## PDP Lesson Plan

### AIM:

Recognize stress factors, SK-6, p.64

### OBJECTIVE:

The student will be able to recognize some stress factors and learn how to deal with them.

### PREPARATION:

Paper, pencil

### MOTIVATION:

A student is driving to the Franklin County Fair at about 8 p.m. to see featured country singer. How could the driver avoid the stress created by driving in the heavy traffic?

### PRESENTATION:

Have student list 10 factors that cause stress and rate each factor on a scale of one to ten. Compare the responses. Ask the students if they know what causes stress and any technique they know to deal with stress.

### REFERENCES:

Use a local newspaper to find examples of "road rage"

### HOMEWORK:

Make a list of ten stress reducers and relate how the person with "road rage" could have dealt with the stress situation better. Present this to the class.

## PDP LESSON PLAN

### AIM:

To have students develop an awareness of differences in cultures (cultural diversity) and equity issues and how they will affect students throughout their lives in their dealings with others.

### OBJECTIVE:

Students will become more aware of the diverse world in which we live: society trends, global community. Student will have a better understanding and respect for others of different ethnic backgrounds and abilities.

### PREPARATION:

Review amendments that lay foundation for equality of all / articles assembled regarding hate groups, civil rights organizations and any studies regarding trends / discuss historical background of discrimination in various forms.

### MOTIVATION:

Have students do a skit regarding discrimination / share experiences / pretend you are someone from a background different from yours.

### PRESENTATION:

Get gauge of students' experience with minorities or those different / touch on issues involving the handicapped or the emotionally disturbed

### REFERENCES:

Guest speaker, videos, interview / have people from different ethnic backgrounds visit classroom and share their experience.

### HOMEWORK:

Have student do essay on why it is important to be able to understand and respect other cultures and those of different capabilities / do reports on different holidays celebrated, etc.

### AIM:

Set documentary film "Shadow of Hate," detailing intolerance in the U.S.

### PRESENTATION:

Class will review a list of attributes often given to diverse cultures and be asked to determine whether or not they agree. Then class will as a group discuss why they believe what they do. Then work on dispelling stereotypes will be discussed.

## PDP LESSON PLAN

### AIM:

Recognizing stress factors and being able to reduce them

### OBJECTIVE:

At the end of class/lesson, students should be able to recognize elements which bring them stress.

### PREPARATION:

Paper, and pens for "quiz"

Histogram for charting the stress factors

### MOTIVATION:

Record stresses

### PRESENTATION:

- Chart the stress histograms
- Students rate stress factors in their lives (using form on page. 64, SK-6)
- Identify stresses in common with other students
- Have a positive stress reducer

Guest speaker

Internet information search about stress and how to handle stress

### HOMEWORK:

Have parents fill out stress factor scale in their lives (a parent and non-family member)

### AIM:

Plan and implement with confidence a community service project

### PREPARATION:

Research and assess community needs, develop list of possible projects, discuss feasibility of each, choose one project, develop project guide

### MOTIVATION:

Guest speakers

### PRESENTATION:

Mechanics (steps) to carry out a project

### REFERENCES:

City officials (engineer, public works)

### HOMEWORK:

Research projects that have been tried in other towns and how the projects were accomplished

## PDP LESSON PLAN

### AIM:

Organize and complete an employment portfolio

### OBJECTIVE:

- Practice organizational skills to organize and complete a portfolio
- Able to update and polish portfolio over time as needed
- Able to present portfolio to employers effectively

### PREPARATION:

- Sample portfolios for students to examine as examples in several formats
- Tell students to bring in pieces of their work to include in the portfolio with sample of best work, resume, etc.
- Folders to use to hold completed product

### MOTIVATION:

- Story, portfolio can get you a job vs. no portfolio, no job, competitive edge
- Identify the uses of the portfolio, use to apply for scholarships / college/technical educ., get a job, etc.
- Emphasize you will use this throughout life, not just for this class

### PRESENTATION:

- Present samples, have students examine, critique, discuss, etc.
- Teacher give students some parameters on what needs to be included (resumes in different styles, cover letter, sample resignation letter, sample application, letters of recommendation, achievements, etc.)
- Students work on compiling portfolio

### REFERENCES:

- Reference on "how-to" write resumes, cover letters
- Personnel magazines with articles on what employers look for

### HOMEWORK:

Data collection, call for reference / gather info to include, etc.

Next class, present to small group

## PDP LESSON PLAN

### AIM:

Develop and make a presentation promoting your career choice.

### OBJECTIVE:

The student will give a 5-minute oral presentation on a career of the student's choice, using visual aids and a list of at least 5 resources, one of which is an interview of a professional and no more than 1/2 the resources from the internet

### PREPARATION:

Internet access / Library access / Access to Professionals / Computer Access / Career Path Information for each student / Poster board / Notecards / transparencies / video camera / overhead projector / internet bookmarks

### MOTIVATION:

Bring in employment services or show a video to highlight some possible careers

### PRESENTATION:

Give a brief presentation on why you chose to be a teacher.

### REFERENCES:

Library, internet, employment services, guidance counselor, professionals, media specialist, art teacher

### HOMEWORK:

Developing written portion of speech and visual aids

Practicing presentation

Keeping a work log of time spent on development
