Call for service: Unattended death

Dispatch has received a call that family members have been trying to reach Mr. _____ for three days, and it is unlike him not to answer the phone. His son/daughter is en route to the residence from Kansas, but wanted the Police Department to send an officer to check on his welfare. Officer is met at the door by the son/daughter who is unlocking the door as the officer arrives.

Mr. _____ is dead sitting on the toilet. He appears to have died of natural causes. If asked the son/daughter is to inform the officer his/her father had been ill for many years with different heart troubles. Son/daughter is very upset.

The call is ended when the officer calls for the Coroner/Medical Examiner.

When he/she came home from work the neighbor had blown leaves into his/her yard. If asked why the neighbor might do this, he or she responds...the neighbor got in trouble for having too many dogs and the neighbor thinks he/she made the complaint, but they didn't.

Officer Assist

Call for Service: Assist the officer.

Officer hears radio traffic from a fellow officer who is on an alarm call stating “possible shots fired”. Dispatch cannot make contact with the officer on the call. The emergency button on the officer’s radio has been activated and Dispatch is still unable to make contact. Officer is the first to arrive on the scene. The alarm is no longer sounding, and all is quiet.

Officer on the alarm call has accidentally set off his emergency button, and somehow his radio got turned off as he was walking through the building. The shots fired were from a car backfiring outside the building. The officer is in an area where he can’t be seen or heard.
