3. **12300 METCALF AVE** is on the **RIGHT.** go 0.0 mi

Emergency Preparedness

Please familiarize yourself with the For Your Safety In An Emergency information on the back of your guest room door upon arrival.

Upon Arrival

- Locate fire exits and staircases.
- Locate the alarm pull stations and the fire extinguisher on your floor.

In Case of Fire

- Stay calm.
- Pull the nearest fire alarm.
- Close doors around the fire area.
- If you detect fire or smoke, call AYS by dialing 0 on the nearest phone.

If you leave your room

- Feel the door to see it is hot.
- If it is not hot, open the door slightly to see if you can make it to the nearest evacuation stairwell to exit the building.
- Stay low to the floor and take your room key. Do not use the elevators.
- Walk down the exit staircase.
- If the stairwell is filled with smoke, return to your guest room.
- Seal the guest room door with wet towels.

If you cannot leave your room

- Call AYS by dialing 0 on the nearest phone and report your room number.
- Wedge a wet towel around/under the door and vents.
- Run water in the sink and bathtub to use to keep towels wet that are keeping smoke out of your room.
- Do not attempt to break any windows.
- Stay low to the floor of your guest room and wait for help.

Inclement Weather Conditions

Tornado Warning (Given when moving people to shelter)

- In the event of a tornado warning or severe weather, the hotel's Fire Alarm System will be activated to instruct you to take immediate precautions.
- Proceed to the lobby level using the stairs. Do not use the elevator.
- Hotel staff will be available to direct you to the safest area.
- Stay away from hallways and windows.
- When conditions permit, an all clear announcement will be issued indicating it is safe to resume normal activities.

Tornado Take Cover Warning (Given when tornado is about to strike hotel)

- In the event of a tornado sited in the immediate area, the hotel's fire alarm System will be activated to instruct you to take cover immediately.
- Move into a shelter area and face interior walls and assume a sitting position. In guest rooms, the shelter area would be the bathroom.
- Place your head between your knees and hug your legs with your arms.
- If mattresses are nearby, cover yourself with the mattress.
- Remain in your covered position until an all clear is given by the staff.
- If you are hurt contact a hotel associate.

- When conditions permit, an all clear announcement will be issued indicating it is safe to resume normal activities.
