



GAME INSTRUCTIONS

Welcome to SkillsUSA Jeopardy!

This is a game-based learning activity that will test your student's knowledge of all things SkillsUSA! This game is very similar to the televised version of the game: answers are presented on the game board and contestants must respond in the form of a question. Each SkillsUSA related category has a point value. The members will choose a category and point value, and the advisor will set a time limit for the member answering the question. If the member or team is correct and answers within the time frame, they are awarded the point value of the question. Continue until all questions have been answered. The team with the most points wins!

Types of Questions

There are six categories, and under each category there are five questions in the first round of Jeopardy. These questions increase in value and difficulty. Once the first round of questions has been played, members may continue on to Double Jeopardy. As in the first round, there are six categories and five questions under each category. However, the point value has now doubled. Once the questions in Double Jeopardy have been played, members may play Final Jeopardy. A category is announced by the host, and the members will write down a wager based on the category. They can wager as little as zero points up to as many points as they have accumulated. The host will ask the question, and the members will have 30 seconds to write a response.

SkillsUSA Jeopardy! Game Directions

SkillsUSA Jeopardy covers a list of topics such as the SkillsUSA Framework, the Chapter Excellence Program, SkillsUSA events and SkillsUSA facts. This is a fun way for students to have friendly competition with one another while testing their knowledge of SkillsUSA. Pick one student to start the game by selecting a question. This student may answer aloud. If correct, this same student may pick the next question to answer. If incorrect, the next student should pick the next question. All students can participate via the included score card. To score the game, students should record their answer in the appropriate box of the scorecard prior to the answer being revealed. Once revealed, students should mark the questions they get correct with a check mark and the questions they get incorrect with an "x".

SkillsUSA Jeopardy! Technical Directions

SkillsUSA Jeopardy is ran via Microsoft PowerPoint. To play the game, please display the presentation in full screen presentation mode. Questions may be selected by clicking the appropriate dollar amount on the main game board. (Please note that the arrow keys/space-bar of your keyboard should not be used to manipulate this presentation) Once the selected question has been answered by a student, clicking anywhere in the blue background will advance the presentation to the answer slide for that question. After reviewing the answer, you can return to the main game board by clicking anywhere in the blue background. Once returned to the main game board, the previously selected question will disappear from the board to prevent it from being selected again.

Tip: Do not minimize the presentation during the middle of your game! This will cause all of the previously answered questions to be re-displayed on the main game board.

Looking to end your game? Use final Jeopardy!

To access final Jeopardy, click the top right category name on the main game board. This hidden link will take you directly to final Jeopardy, should you wish to end your game.
