- Describe the car color (Large panel)
- Look for possible mixing color solutions
- Choose the most probable correction
- Make color adjustment and evaluate progress
- o Record the process.

To start . . .

- 1. Make a spray-out of the original color.
- 2. Add 10% of the original amount of the toner being used to make adjustments.
- 3. When a noticeable change has occurred make a sprayout and compare it to the original spray out and the car.
- 4. Estimate the percentage of movement made and the amount needed to make the correction.
- 5. Add that amount and repeat steps 3 & 4 as needed.
