

- Describe the car color (Large panel)
- Look for possible mixing color solutions
- Choose the most probable correction
- Make color adjustment and evaluate progress
- Record the process.

To start . . .

1. Make a spray-out of the original color.
2. Add 10% of the original amount of the toner being used to make adjustments.
3. When a noticeable change has occurred make a spray-out and compare it to the original spray out and the car.
4. Estimate the percentage of movement made and the amount needed to make the correction.
5. Add that amount and repeat steps 3 & 4 as needed.
